



## Prairie Band Casino & Resort Celebrates Groundbreaking of Second Phase of Expansion

Prairie Band Casino & Resort, a wholly owned subsidiary of the Prairie Band Potawatomi Nation, will enter the second phase of a two-year expansion project in Mayetta, Kansas. Prairie Band tribal council and board members will be present at the groundbreaking ceremony scheduled for July 19 at 4 p.m. Renovations are due to be completed in the fall of 2020.

“Our continued vision is to be a premier employer. With this expansion we will be adding positions, which will give current staff career growth as well as offer new opportunities for employment in the area,” said president of PBP Entertainment Corporation Frank Tecumseh.

Currently being developed by general contractor Woodstone and Prairie Band Construction and designed by the architectural firm TBE, the Prairie Band Casino & Resort will feature 74 new guest rooms including two- and three-bay suites. Other amenities include indoor and outdoor swimming pools, dry sauna and steam room, fitness center, patio, game room with virtual Top Golf suite, multi-use rooms for parties and business meetings and an outdoor video screen for sporting events or movies.

The expansion of the property is part of the company’s strategy to add more entertainment options and be a destination for families of all ages. “The Prairie Band Potawatomi Board of Directors is ecstatic to begin this phase of our expansion project. These new amenities will differentiate us from our competitors and keep Prairie Band Casino & Resort as the premier destination for entertainment, golf and gaming,” said Tecumseh.

The first phase of the expansion began in 2018 with a new lobby bar, featuring specialty cocktails and local beers; the Kapi coffee bar; the Embers Bar and Grille; and extensive cosmetic improvements to the casino floor. Guests returning to the casino floor will notice vibrant wall treatments, upgraded lighting, enhanced ceiling décor and a new carpet and floor design.

The casino offers more than 1,100 slot machines including Class II games; a 400-seat bingo hall; and 25 table games including blackjack, craps and roulette. There are four dining options, lobby bar, luxury hotel, on-site convenience store and RV park. The 12,000-square-foot Great Lakes Ballroom plays host to concerts and other live performances, and the award-winning Firekeeper Golf Course is only steps away.
