The Tribal Council directed all of the Nation's gaming facilities to suspend operations at 11:59 p.m., March 17, 2020.**

**We will announce our scheduled re-opening by email, social media, public communications and prairieband.com once that has been determined by the Prairie Band Potawatomi Nation. Until then, guests that have future hotel reservations will receive full refunds. All casino promotions will be suspended during this time.**
