Offering this meal allows our elders that can commute the opportunity to socialize and partake in our center's daily activities. Our qualified homebound elders are delivered a fresh daily meal. We provide culturally based activities and meals throughout the year. We can assist with referrals, outreach and transportation to entities and resources to meet their needs. We offer basic medical equipment to be loaned for short term use and provide supplemental resources.

Our goal is to allow an elder to remain at home for as long as possible with their own support system. Caregivers play a huge role in this process. That is why we have a Caregiver Program specifically designed to help caregivers. Our caregiver program offers support in various ways to prevent burn-out and stress overload.
