Junior Achievement Topeka & Junior Achievement of Kansas:

Junior Achievement (JA) Topeka is a district inside the area of Junior Achievement of Kansas. Our 3 Pillars of focus for students are financial literacy, career readiness, and entrepreneurship. During the 2022-23 school year JA Topeka served over 9,400 students in 457 classrooms with the generosity of over 250 volunteers in Topeka and Shawnee County. One particularly encouraging statistic of JA's national impact is that 1 in 5 JA alumni enter the same field as their JA volunteer that taught a program in their classroom.

Junior Achievement of Kansas was formed in 1957, and over the years we have consolidated our geographic areas of Lawrence, Topeka, and Wichita to cover 101 of the 105 counties in the state. We began as a high school program that primarily met after school. In 1975 in-classroom programming was launched, which is now most of the programming we provide across the state. In the 1990s we officially developed programming for all grades, K-12th. In 2019 we celebrated JA USA's 100th anniversary and look forward to celebrating our JA Kansas 70th anniversary in 2027.
