

The Topeka Impact Foundation was created with the vision of providing children the opportunity to serve in our local community. As kids and families serve together, we invest in the youth and children of Topeka to build healthy environments they need to thrive and empower them to create lasting change in their own lives and communities.

Impact Topeka has three main projects per year, aside from our three staple projects we love to come alongside others and serve to better the community.

Beds Program: Working in partnership with local businesses, Impact Topeka alongside Rest for Success provides new beds, linens, pajamas, pillows and stuffed animals to students at local schools that participate in the bed program. Our hope is for each child to have a bed of their own in hopes to improve the quality of the child's sleep. This in return will impact him/her intellectually, physically, emotionally,and spiritually. The Program only serves children who do NOT currently have a bed of their own. This program happens 2x/year, once in the Fall and once in the Spring. Every student in theschool receives a new book, snack, toothbrush and toothpaste regardless of if they have a bed or not. Each year this program alone impacts over 1000 children in our community.

Holiday Meal Program: Over the holidays we prepare over 70 meal boxes for families to ensure children in our community have a holiday meal to enjoy with their family. Each box included a fully cooked ham, canned vegetables, pasta salads, bread, pie, fruit and a can opener. We also provide a board game, hats and gloves and a stuffed animal to each child.

Back to School Program: Each school year we will work with one school to provide a "Back to School" shopping experience for around 100 students. Students are invited to come to the school a week before school is back in session. We will provide new book bags, school supplies and much more!
